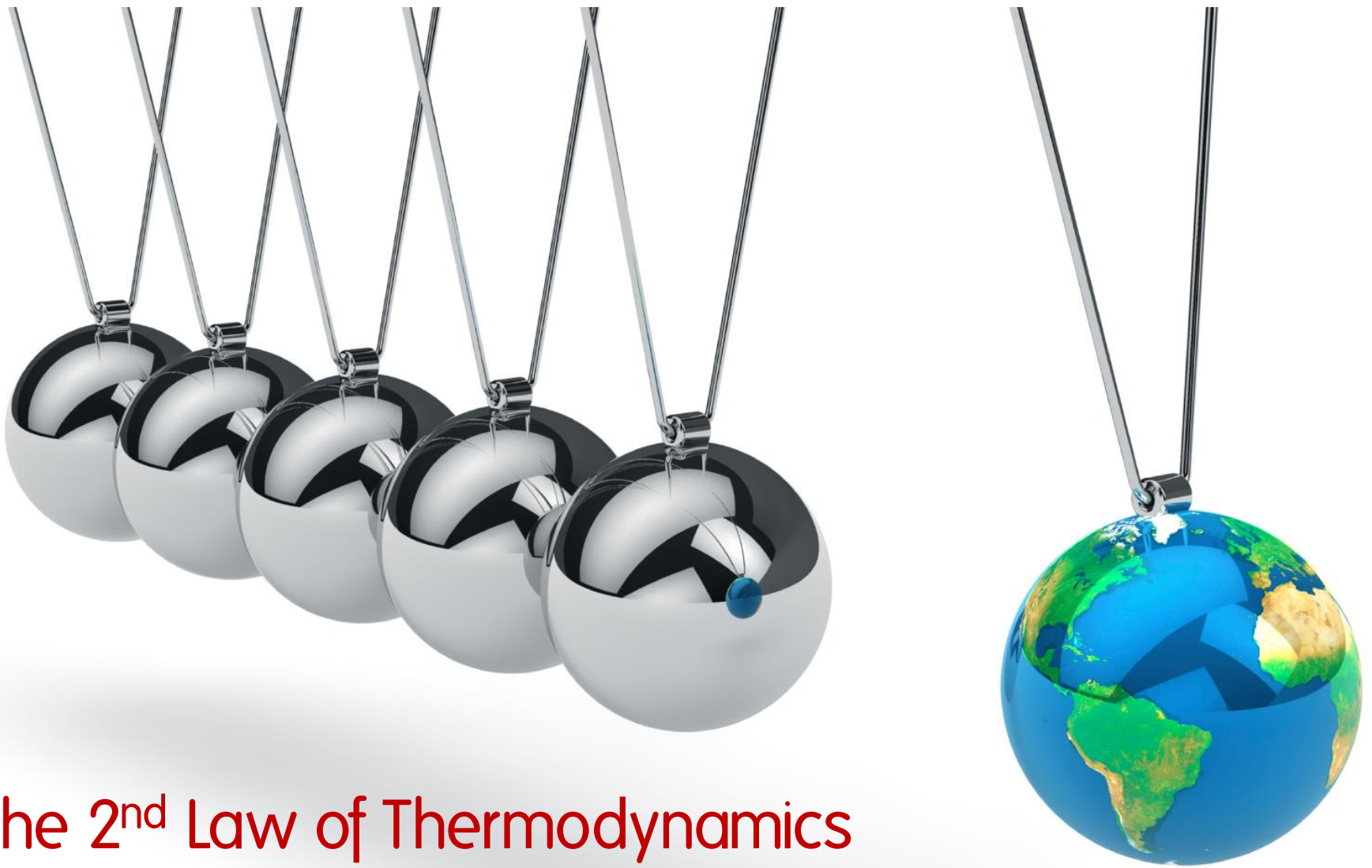

The 1st Law of Thermodynamics



The law of conservation of energy states that the total energy of **an isolated system is constant**; energy can be transformed from one form to another, but **cannot be created or destroyed.**



The 2nd Law of Thermodynamics

The second law of thermodynamics states that in a natural thermodynamic process, there is an **increase** in the sum of the **entropies** (disorder) of the participating systems.
