


For by grace have

(Eph 2:8-9)





fall from their masters' table.”

Led to Sight  
(Mk 10:46-52)

And many rebuked him, telling him to be silent. But he cried out all the more, “Son of David, have mercy on me!”

And **throwing off his cloak**, he sprang up and came to Jesus.

And Jesus said to him, “Go your way; your faith has made you well. And immediately he recovered his sight and followed Him on the way.”

(Lk 7:37-50)
