There are two major words in the NT for

BLESSING

<u>Makarizo</u> — Large, lengthy, long. It means big things for you or contentment and happy.

<u>Eulogeo</u> – Speak well. Celebrate with praise, acknowledge goodness, desire for glory, using words to exalt a person or thing.

GOD THE FATHER HATH BLESSED US THERE ARE FOUR IMPORTANT QUESTIONS

- 1. WHO IS DOING THE BLESSING? The answer is always GOD
- 2. WHO IS BLESSED? The answer is always US
- 3. HOW ARE WE BLESSED? The answer is always BY CHRIST
- 4. WHERE ARE WE BLESSED? The answer is always IN CHRIST

LOOK AT HOW MANY TIMES THESE THINGS ARE STATED IN JUST THE FIRST 13 VERSES

Eph 1:7-13

In Him We have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace which He made to abound toward US in all wisdom and prudence, having made known to US the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Himself, that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth in Him. In Him also We have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will, that We who first trusted in Christ should be to the praise of His glory.
