**We often confuse teaching with evangelism
– they are not the same thing!**

synagogue, but when
Priscilla and Aquila
heard him, they took
him and explained to
him the way of God
more accurately.
(Acts 18:26)

This is
teaching

And leaping up, he stood,
and began to walk; and
he entered with them
into the temple, walking,
and leaping, and praising
God. And all the people
saw him walking and
praising God: (Acts 3:8-9)

EVANGELIST: a bringer of good tidings, to bring good news, to announce glad tidings

TEACHER: a teacher, one who is fitted to teach, or thinks himself so, sometimes translated 'master' or 'rabbi'

There is a need for us to strive to be better at both of these jobs (Matt 5:15, Heb 5:12), but they are different jobs
