This verse is where teaching begins and evangelism ends.

And He gave some to be apostles; and some, prophets; and some evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; (Ephesians 4:11)

## We often confuse teaching with evangelism – they are not the same thing!

He began to speak boldly in the synagogue, but when Priscilla and Aquila heard him, they took him and explained to him the way of God more accurately.

(Acts 18:26)

This is evangelism

This is teaching

And leaping up, he stood, and began to walk; and he entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God. And all the people saw him walking and praising God: (Acts 3:8-9)

**EVANGELIST:** a bringer of good tidings, to bring good news, to announce glad tidings

TEACHER: a teacher, one who is fitted to teach, or thinks himself so, sometimes translated 'master' or 'rabbi'

There is a need for us to strive to be better at both of these jobs (Matt 5:15, Heb 5:12), but they are different jobs

AFTER Philip got in the chariot, he began to teach the eunuch.

BEFORE Philip climbed into the chariot, he was evangelizing.
