WICKEDNESS

Any and all evil. An evil disposition. A desire to injure

GUILE

To catch with bait. Deceive. Crafty

HYPOCRISIES

Deceitful actions, attitudes, words. "Play acting."

ENVIES

Feelings of unhappiness at the good fortune of another.

EVIL SPEAKING

Slandorous or defamatory statements. Backbiting
2 Cor. 12:20

1 Peter 2:2 as newborn babes, long for the spiritual milk which is without guile, that ye may grow thereby unto salvation

BABES**

Peter has already referred to the new birth twice. 1:3, 23

Jesus in Jn. 3:3-5; Paul in 1 Cor. 4:15

Strongly desire. Lust after.

MILK

The food a baby must have. (1 Cor. 3:2; Heb. 5:12-14)

SPIRITUAL

Reasonable, that which pertains to the mind. Rom. 12:1

**WITHOUT
GUILE**

Unadulterated. They often mixed milk with gypsum, a white substance rendering the milk impure.

THAT
