**Hebrew parallelism: Refrain = Cease, leave off.
Guile = craft, deceit, guile.**

Let him turn away from evil and do good;

Let him seek peace and pursue it.

**Seek = seek after, strive for.
Pursue = run swiftly, earnestly endeavor to acquire.**
