The word 'faith' shows up over 450 times in the Bible

Faith...

... and the word 'believe' another 250 times.

Aman (Hebrew): to trust or believe, to be permanent or quiet; morally to be true or certain



Pistis (Greek): persuasion, i.e. credence; moral conviction (of religious truth, or the truthfulness of God or a religious teacher), assurance

For (jod so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. John 3:16



He is called the 'father of the faithful' (Rom 4:10-12)

And Abraham <u>believed</u> God, and it was reckoned unto him for righteousness; and he was called the friend of God. (Jas 2:23) For what does the Scripture say? Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness. (Rom 4:3)

BOTH ACCOUNTS DEAL WITH ABRAHAM – ONE REFERS TO HIS WORKS THAT MADE HIS FAITH AND ONE REFERS TO HIS WORKS HAVING NOTHING TO DO WITH FAITH!

Was not Abraham our father justified by works, in that he offered up Isaac his son upon the altar? You see that faith was active along with his works, and faith was completed by his **works**; and the Scripture was fulfilled that says, Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness—and he was called a friend of God. You see that a person is justified by works and not by faith alone. (Jas 2:21-24)

What then shall we say was gained by Abraham, our forefather according to the flesh? For if Abraham was justified by works, he has something to boast about, but not before God. For what does the Scripture say? Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness. Now to the one who works, his wages are not counted as a gift but as his due. (Rom 4:1-4)


