
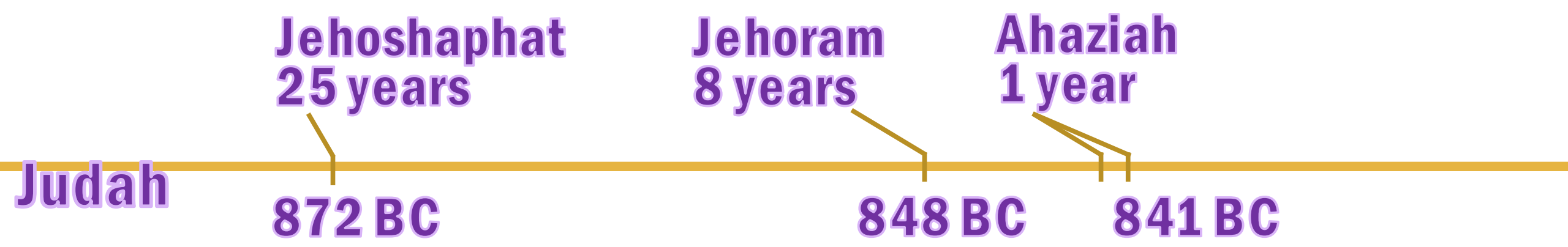
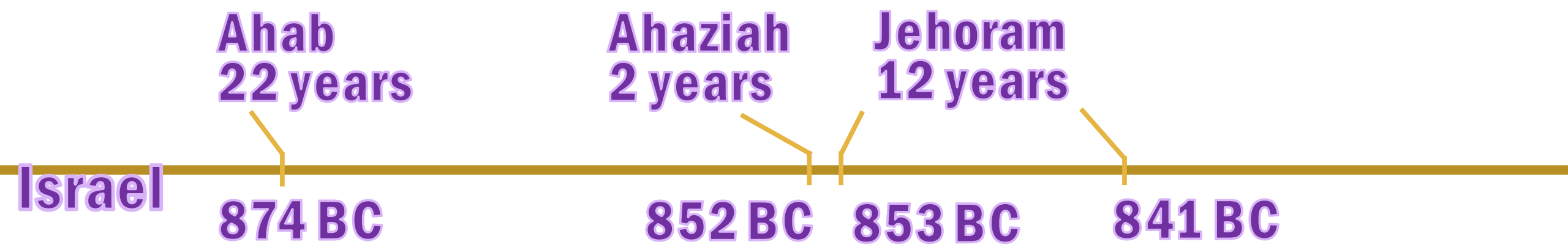

Jehoshaphat, of Judah

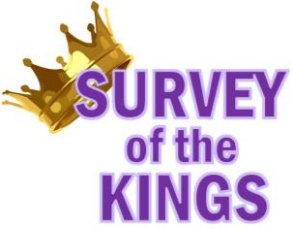
- **Son of Asa**

- **Did not turn aside from doing right in the sight of the LORD**

“He took great pride in the ways of the Lord...he sent his officials and...they taught in Judah, having the book of the law of the LORD with them...”

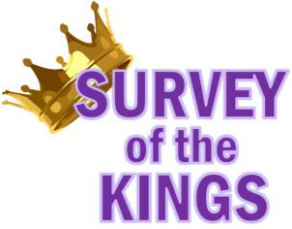

the LORD has destroyed your works’ ”**

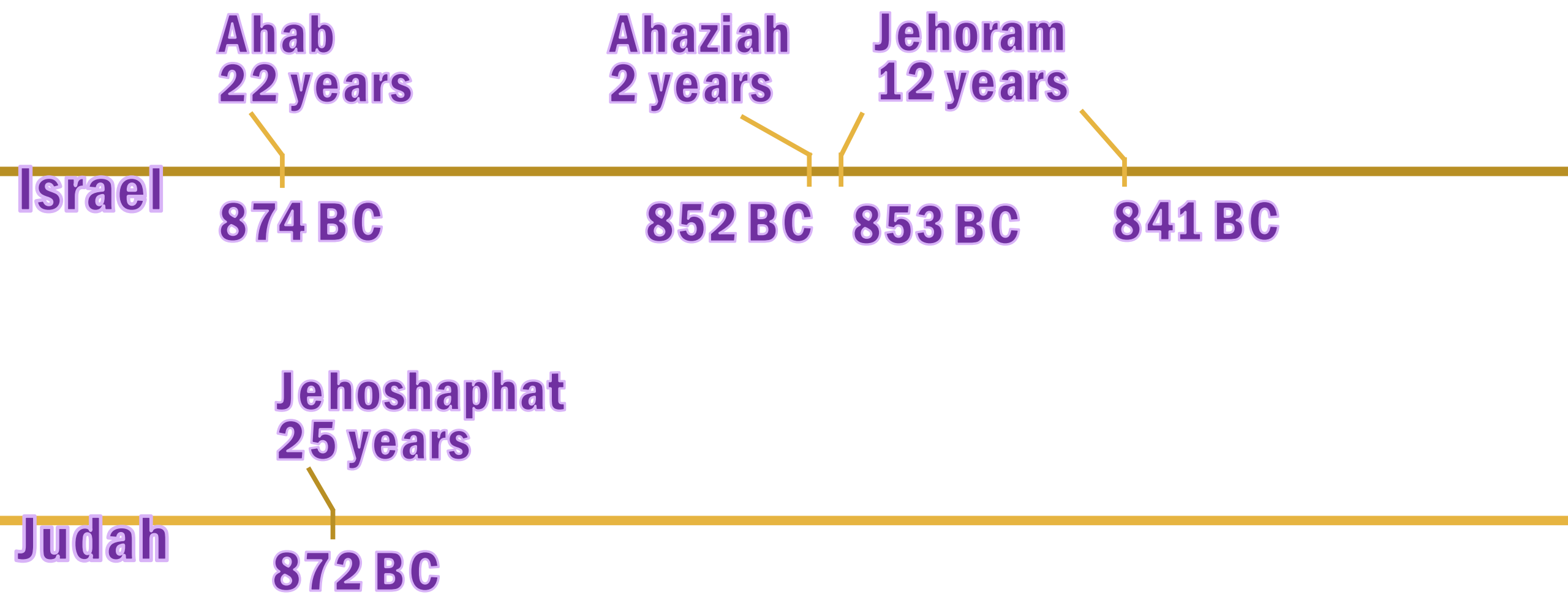
2 Chronicles 20:37

Jehoram, of Israel

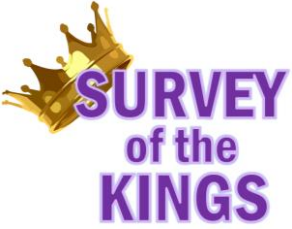
“Then he went and sent word to Jehoshaphat the king of Judah, saying ‘The king of Moab has rebelled against me...’ ”

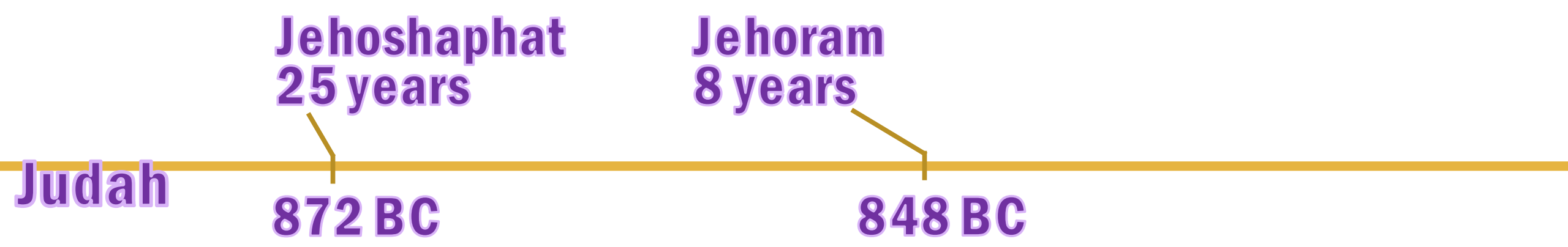
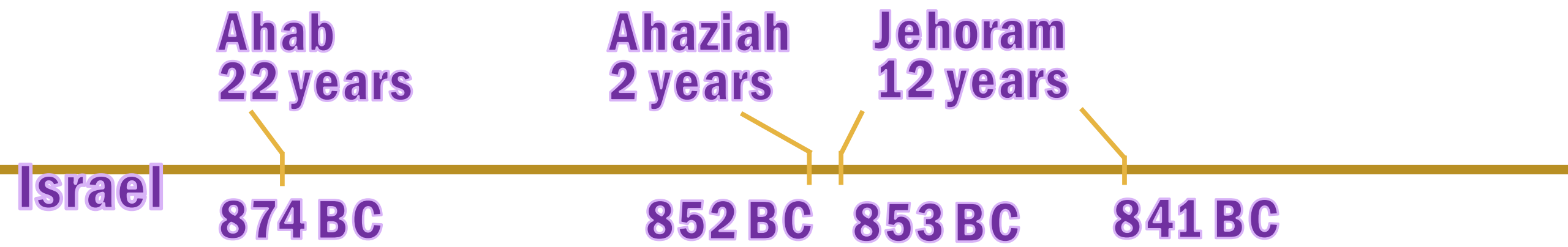


Jehoshaphat, of Judah

Jehoram, of Judah

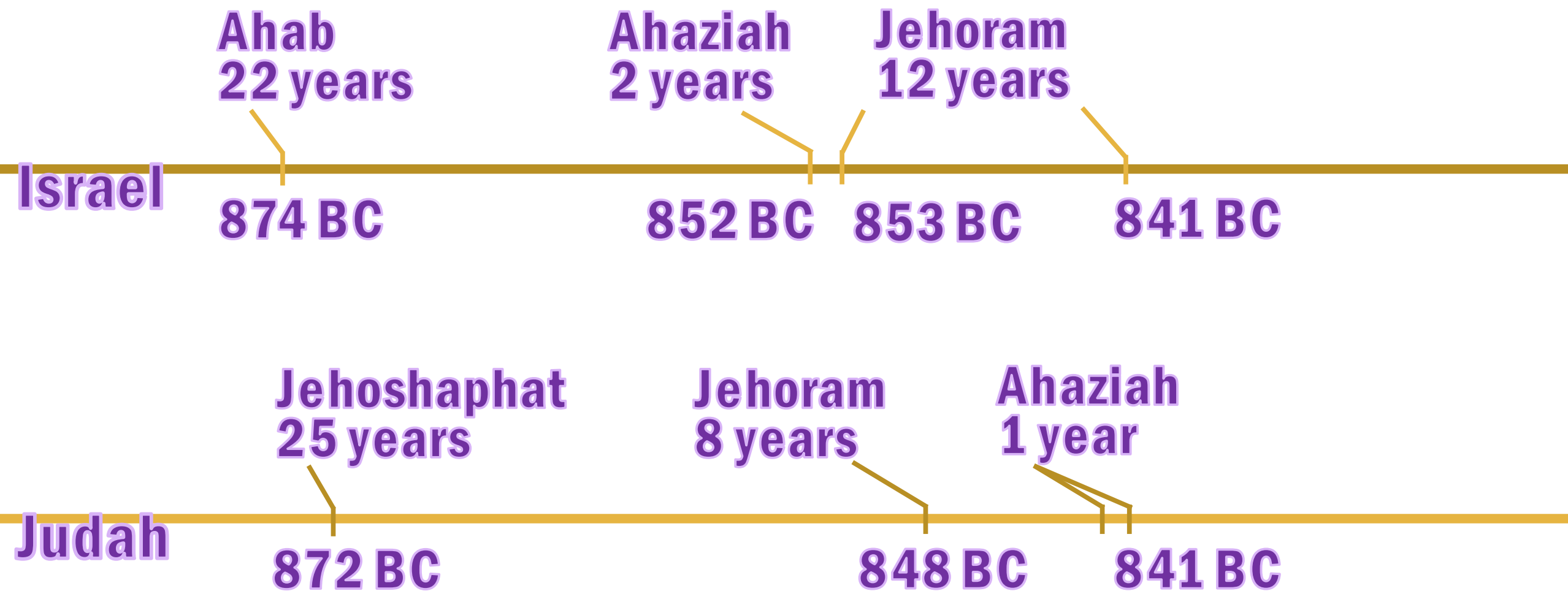
“He walked in the ways of the kings of Israel, just as the house of Ahab had done, for the daughter of Ahab was his wife.”
