

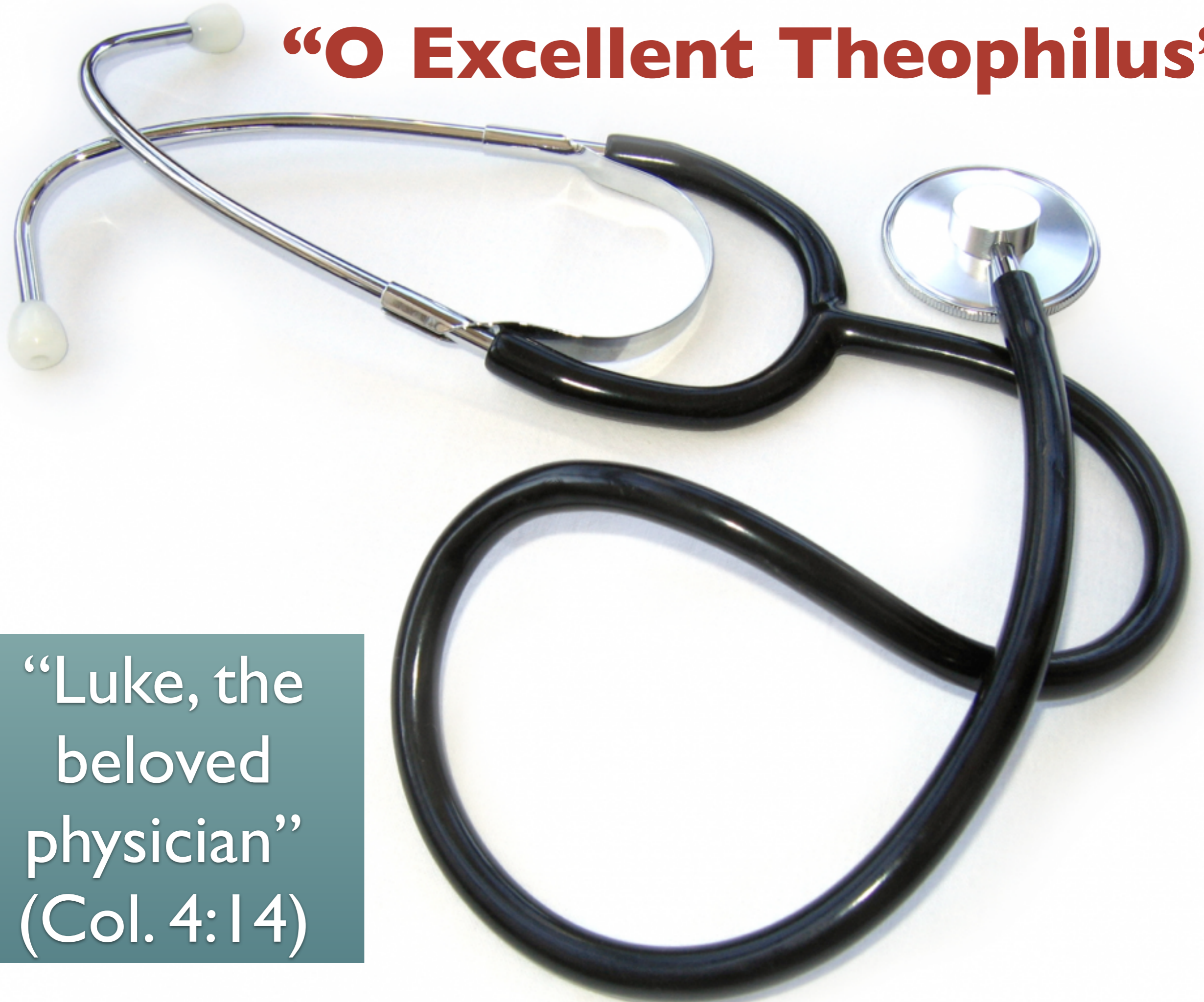


Acts of Apostles is a much neglected book. It was so in the days of Chrysostom, who lived in the 5th century, and who says:

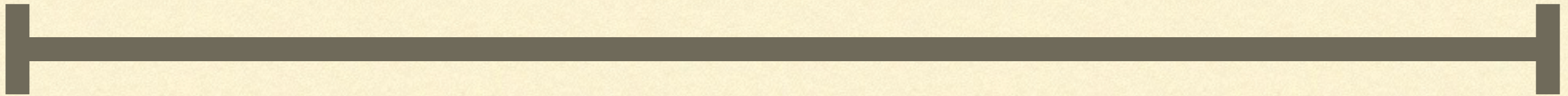

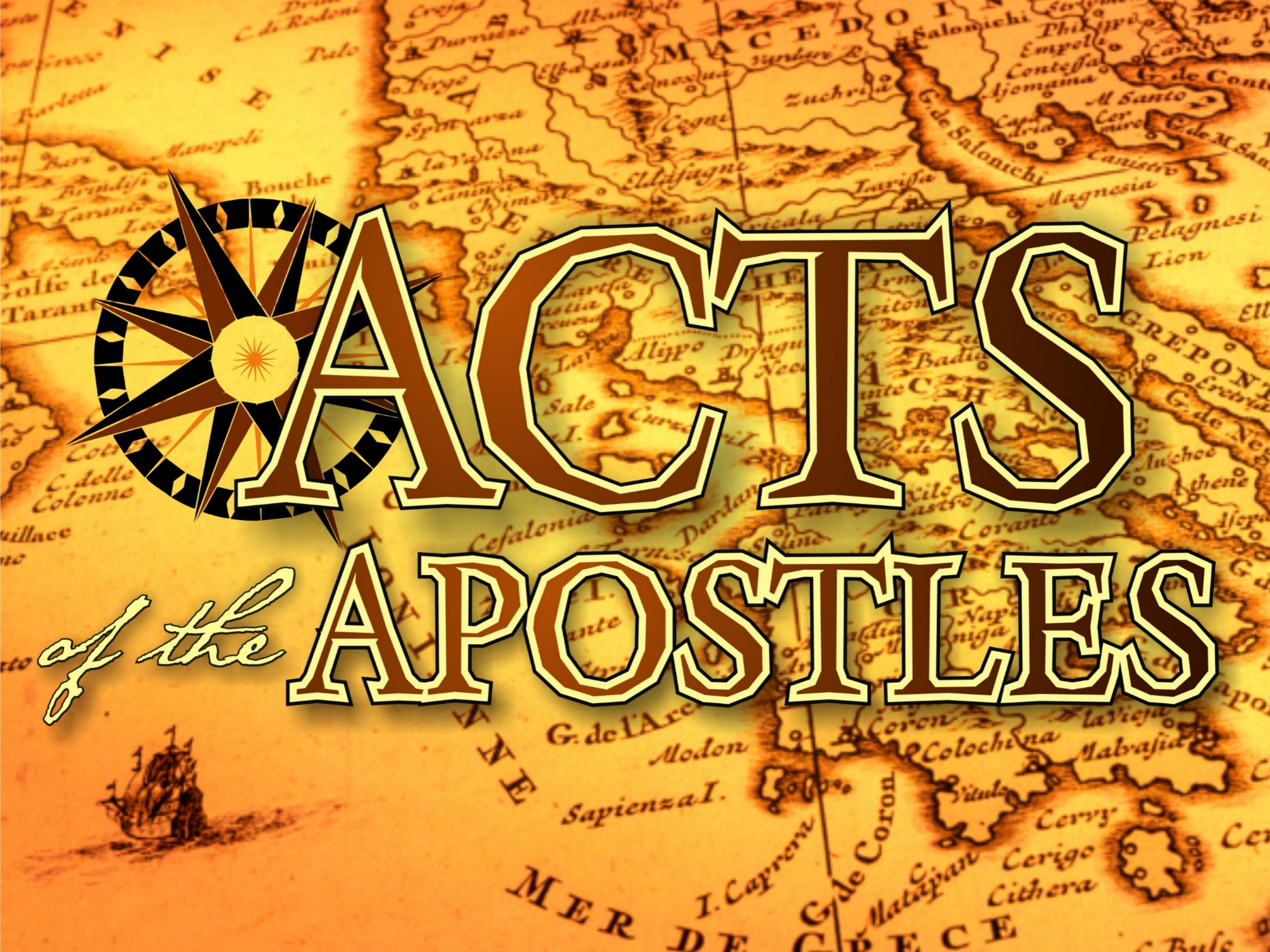
