Eph 6:1-3 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.

Mark 7:10-13 For Moses said, **'Honor your father and your mother'**; and, **'He who curses father or mother, let him be put to death.'** But you say, 'If a man says to his father or mother, **"Whatever profit you might have received from me is Corban"** — ' (that is, a gift to God), then you no longer let him do anything for his father or his mother, making the word of God of no effect through your tradition which you have handed down.



PARENTS SHOULD BE HONORED BY THEIR CHILDREN



Exod 20:12 *Honour thy father* and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

Deut 5:16 *Honour thy father* and thy mother, as the LORD thy God hath commanded thee; that thy days may be prolonged, and that it may go well with thee, in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

FATHERS ARE GOD'S INSTRUMENTS OF CHASTENING FOR CHILDREN

THIS IS A GREAT DANGER EVEN WHEN GOD CHASTENS HIS CHILDREN

Heb 12:5-10

5 And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him:

6 For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth.

7 If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not?

8 But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye illegitimate, and not sons.

9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us,

5. NOT AN EXAMPLE - 1 Pet. 5:3

FATHERS TO CHILDREN



Eph 6:4 And you, fathers, . . . but **nurture** them in the **training and admonition** of the Lord.

NURTURE

To nurture, support, to feed, to give suck, fatten, to bring up

TRAINING

The whole training and education of children.

ADMONITION

Correction and training by word, whereas the “training” above refers more to the training by action and discipline. This refers to the words of encouragement and correction.

GOD'S INSTRUCTIONS CONCERNING THE
DANGERS
EACH RELATIONSHIP HAS

HUSBANDS – Not loving their wives

WIVES – Not being in subjection to their husbands

CHILDREN – Not being obedient or honoring their parents

FATHERS – Causing their children to become wrathful

SERVANTS – Not properly serving their masters

MASTERS – Not treating their servants properly
