

WHAT & WHO CAUSED THE APOSTASIES


1 Tim 4:1 Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will **depart from the faith**, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons

2 Thess 2:3 Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless **the falling away comes first**, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition

Acts 20:29-31 For I know this, that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock. The nation of Israel had elders.

The cities within the nation of Israel had elders.

Other nations and cities around Israel had elders

The Jewish synagogues had elders

They were like our City Council and their authority was RESTRICTED to that one city.




The office by the name of "ELDERS" was a group of rulers selected to rule with wisdom **because of their age.**

Age does not guarantee wisdom, but it is necessary for wisdom. If a person is wise at age 30 he should become much wiser as he gets older.

The office was always composed of a plurality of men. If only one person was the ruler he would be known as a King Governor

Dictator




Acts 20:17

THE ELDERS OF THE CHURCH REFERED TO THE BOARD, COMPOSED OF OLDER MEN, WHO RULED THE CONGREGATION.

ELDERS ARE REFERRED TO BY OTHER NAMES

Acts 20:17 And from Miletus he sent to Ephesus, and called to him the **elders** of the church.



ELDERS ARE ALSO CALLED BISHOPS

Acts 20:28 Take heed unto yourselves, and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit hath made you **bishops**,



"An overseer, a man charged with the duty of seeing that things to be done by others are done rightly, any curator, guardian or superintendent . . . spec. *the superintendent, head or overseer of any Christian church."* (Thayer)

A **gentile word** used of a guardian, municipal officer, or someone appointed to take care of the town or district.



ELDERS OR BISHIPS ARE ALSO CALLED SHEPHFRIPS

Acts 20:17 And from Miletus he sent to Ephesus, and called to him the **elders** of the church.

Acts 20:28 Take heed unto yourselves, and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit hath made you **bishops**,

Acts 20:28 **to feed** the church of the Lord which he purchased with his own blood. ELDERS & BISHOPS ARE ALSO CALLED SHEPHERDS

This is the Greek word for **SHEPHERD**



<u>1 Peter 5:1-4</u>

The <u>elders</u> who are among you I exhort, I who am a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that will be revealed: 2 <u>Shepherd</u> the flock of God which is among you, serving as <u>overseers</u>, not by compulsion but willingly, not for dishonest gain but eagerly; 3 nor as being lords over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock;


4 and when the **Chief Shepherd** appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away.



To feed, to tend a flock, keep sheep...to rule, govern...to furnish pasturage or food; to nourish. The presiding officer, manager, director of an assembly: (Thayer)





<u>Diakonos</u> comes from two Greek words and means, **"raising dust by hastening."**

Thayer defines it as: "One who executes the commands of another, esp. Of a master; a servant, attendant, minister."



WHAT IS THE WORK OF A DEACON?

WHEN YOU GO TO THE NEW TESTAMENT YOU LEARN

- 1. There is an office of a deacon.
- 2. There is a work he is to do.
- 3. If he does the work well, he earns a good reputation.
- 4. Deacons in Jerusalem had great responsibilities.
- 5. There are qualification a man must have to be a deacon

BUT IN THE WISDOM OF GOD THERE IS NOT A WORD SAID ABOUT HIS DUTIES



THEREFORE, THE DEACONS WOULD BE THOSE MEN WHO SERVE THEM IN DOING THEIR WORK. THE WORK OF A DEACON WOULD BE **ANY WORK** ASSIGNED BY THE ELDERS TO ACCOMPLISH THE WORK OF THE CHURCH. THIS WORK CHANGES WITH EVERY GENERATION

WE DO HAVE AN EXAMPLE OF DEACONS AT WORK Acts 6

Acts 6:1-4

Now in those days, when the number of the disciples was multiplying, there arose a complaint against the Hebrews by the Hellenists, because their widows were neglected in the daily *distribution* (deaconing). 2 Then the twelve summoned the multitude of the disciples and said,"It is not desirable that we should leave the word of God and *serve* (deacon) tables. 3 Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business; 4 but we will give ourselves continually to prayer and to the *ministry* (deaconing) of the word."
