

Be not unequally yoked with unbelievens: for what fellowship have nighteousness and iniquity? or what communion hath light with dankness? (2 Con 6:14)

Verse 1-6 The obligations of affection in marriage

Verse 7-9 The uniqueness of living as a eunuch

Verse 10-11 Believers are not allowed to divorce
except in case of fornication per Matt 19:9

Verse 12-16 Divorce allowances when married to an unbeliever
believer cannot seek divorce, but can accept one

Verse 17-24 "Brethren, let each one remain with God in that state in which he was called"

 how to deal with previous marriages before becoming a Christian.

 Circumcision (a known doctrine, Ax 15; 16:4, 18:1) given as an example.

 Slavery (a practical example) also used to illustrate the concept

Regardless of previous choices when living as an unbeliever, the moment one becomes a Christian they must live faithfully in whatever state (married or not) that they are currently in.
