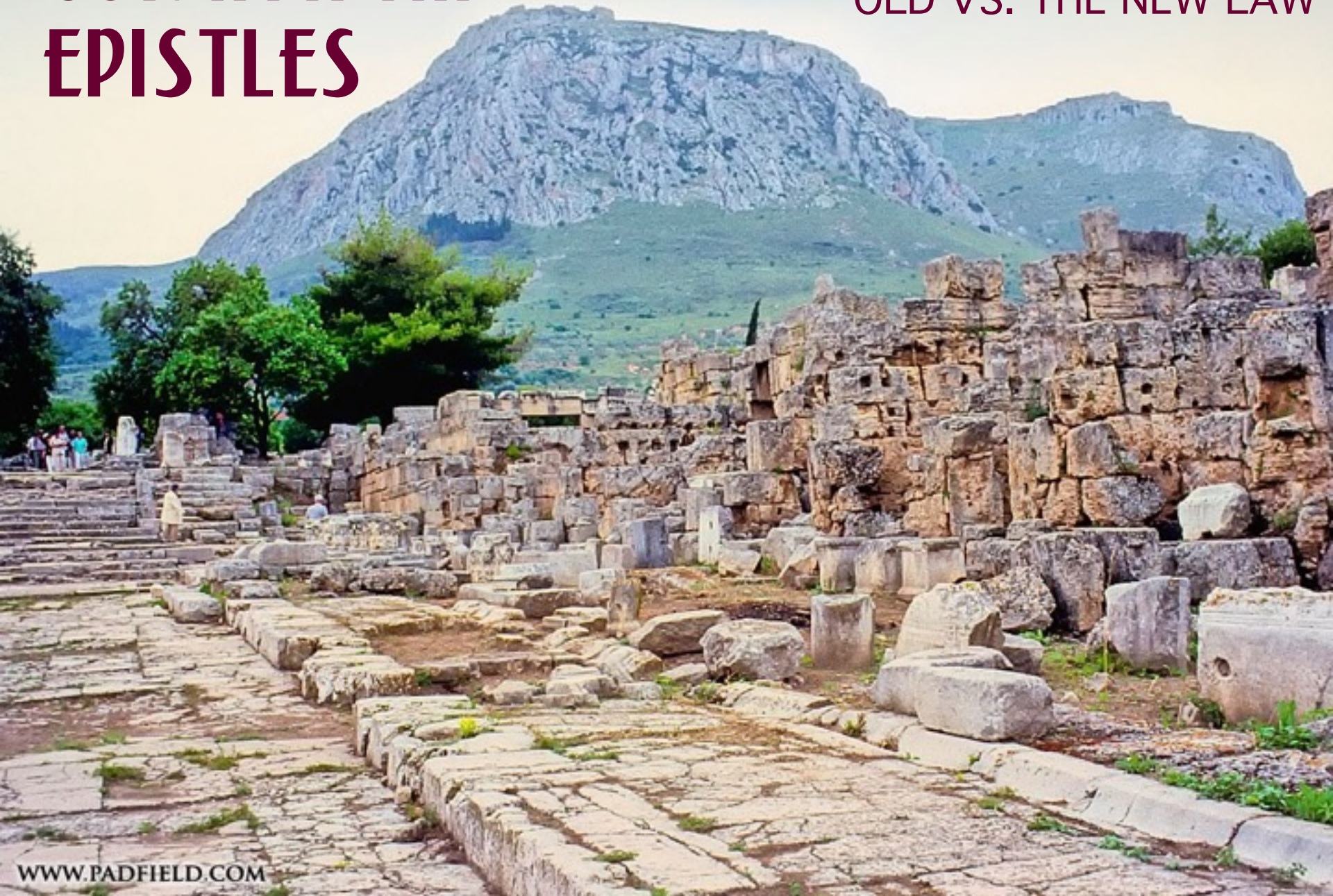

The old law and the Ten Commandments are synonymous (vs. 7)
Ex. 34:1, 4, 28

The old law brings death and punishment (vs 7,9)
Ax 15:10-11; Rom 7:7-12; Gal 3:10-12, 24-25

The old law was always meant to fade (vs 13)
Ex. 33:7-11, 34:29-35

There is a law today, but it is the law of the Spirit (vs. 8-11)
Rom 8:1-4

The old law left you blind to the full picture (vs 14)
