## A CHRISTIAN'S CONDUCT AS WE LIVE BEFORE UNBELIEVERS

## 1 Peter 2:11-12 Beloved, I beg you as sojourners and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul,

12 having your conduct honorable among the Gentiles, that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may, by your good works which they observe, glorify God in the day of visitation.

Sojourners	Beside the house: Stranger, Foreigner
Pilgrims	One who comes from a foreign country into a city or land to reside there by the side of natives.
Abstain	To hold one's self off, abstain.
Fleshly lusts	Strong desires of the flesh: 1 Jn. 2:15
War	To make a military expedition, to lead soldiers to war.
Soul	Rom. 7:7ff; Gal. 5:16ff; 2 Cor. 10:3

1 Peter 2:11-12 Beloved, I beg you as sojourners and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul, 12 having your conduct honorable among the Gentiles, that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may, by your good works which they observe, glorify God in the day of visitation.

Conduct	Manner of life, behavior, conduct
Honorable conduct	Good, beautiful, harmonious, lovely life you live. Your turning from here to there.
Gentiles	In the countries of the dispersion. Heathens
Evildoers	One who does evil, bad, wrong, wicked, injurious
Good works	Opposite of evil. Same word as honorable
Glorify God	Hold in high opinion – Matt. 5:16
Visitation	Overseeing. Same word as bishop. It refers to God visiting them and overseeing a work either bad (Lk. 19:44) or good (Ps. 106:4)
