Rev 21:22 And I saw no temple in the city, for its temple is the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb. 23 And the city has no need of sun or moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and its lamp is the Lamb. 24 By its light will the nations walk, and the kings of the earth will bring their glory into it, 25 and its gates will never be shut by day-and there will be no night there. ²⁶ They will bring into it the glory and the honor of the nations. ²⁷ But nothing unclean will ever enter it, nor anyone who does what is detestable or false, but only those who are written in the Lamb's book of life.

Our bodies will be resurrected in 1 Cor 15:42
Future resurrection is a required doctrine (see 2 Tim 2:18)
It is why Paul shared in Jesus' sufferings (see Php 3:10)
It is our ultimate hope (see Acts 24:15; 23:6)

Heaven is described by Jesus as a resurrection – not merely a new life, but a life that is a replacement, correction, and answer for all that went wrong in the last one.

(Jhn 11:23-24)

He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning nor crying nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away. (Rev 21:4)

Rev 22:3 No longer will there be anything accursed, but the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and His servants will worship Him. 4 They will see His face, and His name will be on their foreheads. ⁵ And night will be no more.
