TAKE UP YOUR CROSS HOW FAR SHOULD OUR COMMITMENT GO?

Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me." (Matt 16:24)

WEAKNESS HOW GOD VIEW'S STRUGGLE
