

# Is Luke 16 a parable? NO

1. It would be the only parable in the Bible that describes things that are outside of the realm of human experience. All the other parables talk about things that humans are familiar with such as birds, seed, fields, pearls, barns, leaven, etc. This passage is different because it talks about two men <u>after death</u>, and this is a realm where none of us have had any personal experience. The purpose of a parable is to compare things we know to things we don't.

The word parable means "to throw beside". Parables throw familiar things physical things next to spiritual concepts. Luke 16 doesn't do this.

- 2. It would be the only parable in the Bible that uses a proper name (Lazarus).
- 3. It would be the only parable in the Bible that makes mention repeatedly of a historical person Abraham. Moreover, this historical person actually carries on a dialogue with the rich man! Indeed, mention is also made in this parable of Moses, another historical character. What other parable speaks of real, historical people?
- 4. It would be the only parable in the Bible that makes mention of angels. Compare Matt. 13:24-49 where angels are mentioned <u>in the explanation</u> of the parable... but not in the parable itself.
- 5. If Hades is not really a place of torment, this would be the only parable in the Bible when the Lord Jesus taught error instead of truth. All of the parables taught things that were true (shepherd with sheep, mustard tree's growth cycle, seed planting, etc.) and then compared those truths to spiritual truths. If Luke 16 is a parable, then it is the only parable that uses completely fabricated mythology.
