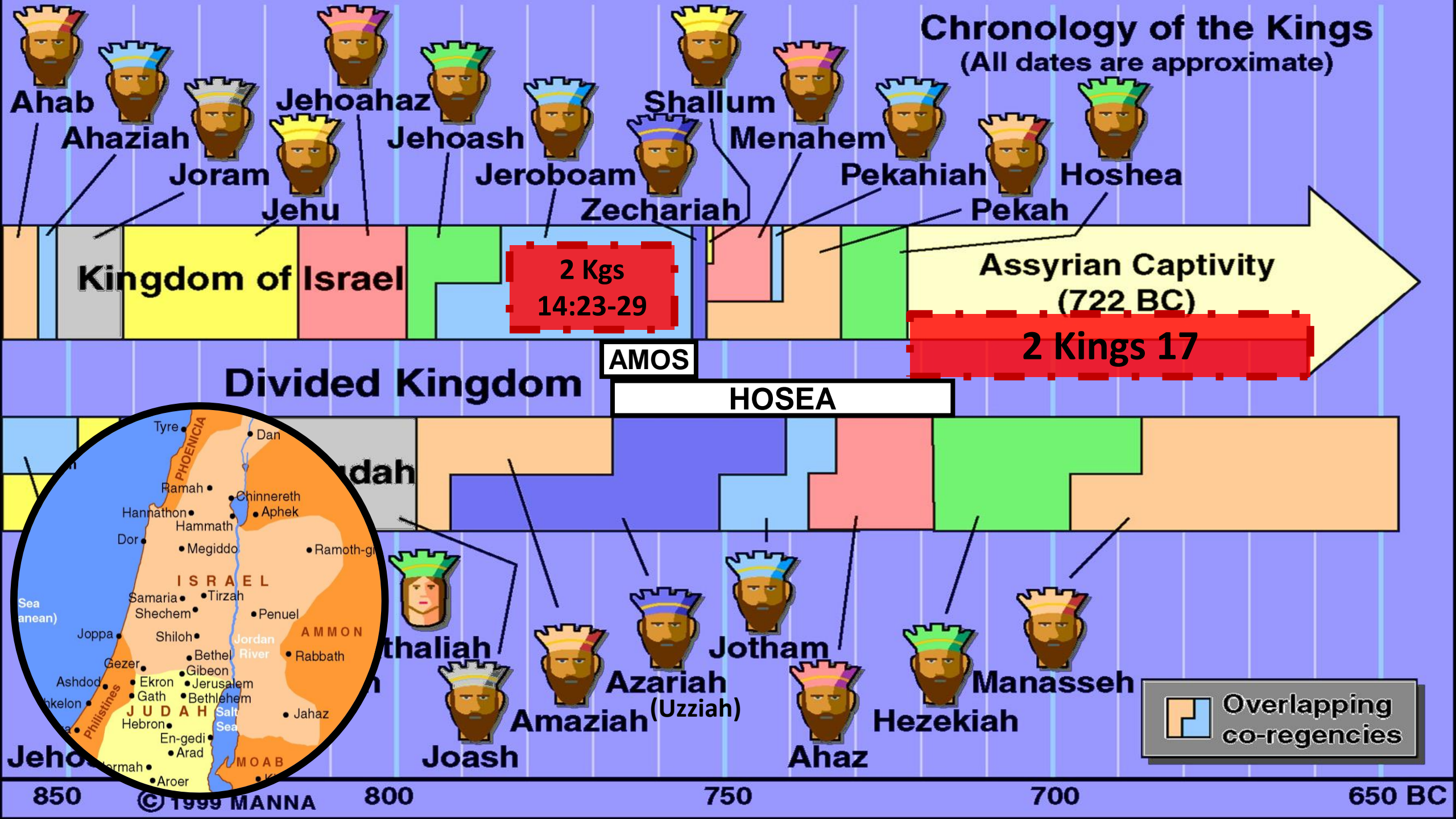

(All dates are approximate)



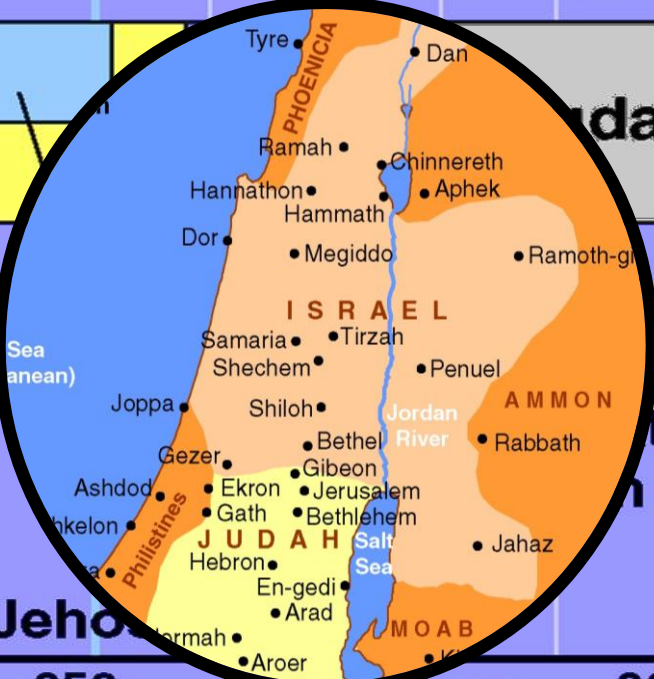

## Jeroboam, King of Israel, Son of Jehoash (יָרֹבָעָם, *yarov'am*)

Also known as Jeroboam II. Grandson of Jehu and son of Joash. The 14th king of the Northern Kingdom of Israel. Reigned 41 years, ca. 786–746 bc. **Successful politically and militarily**—he extended the boundaries of the northern kingdom (2 Kgs 14:25, 28) but “did evil in the sight of God” (2 Kgs 14:24). Jeroboam’s reign is contained only in 2 Kgs 14:23–29.

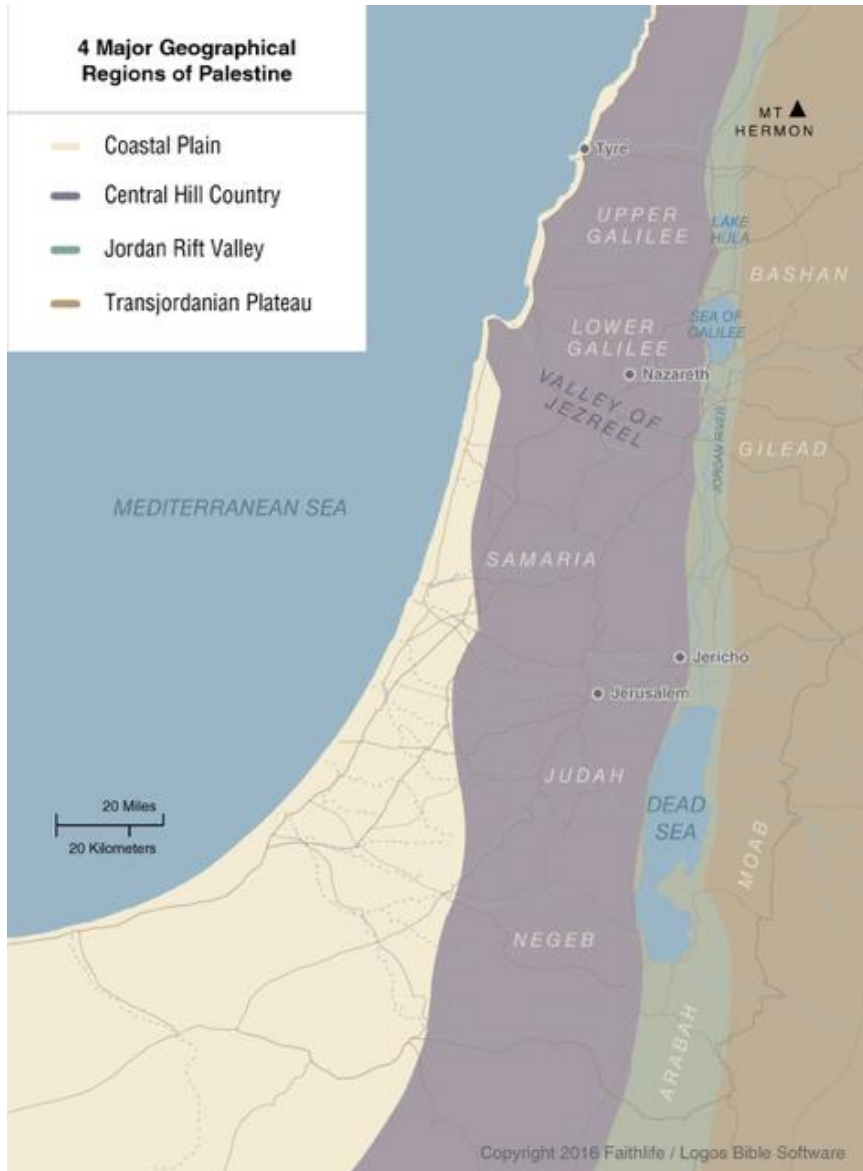


# Nimrud Ivory of a Lioness Killing a Nubian

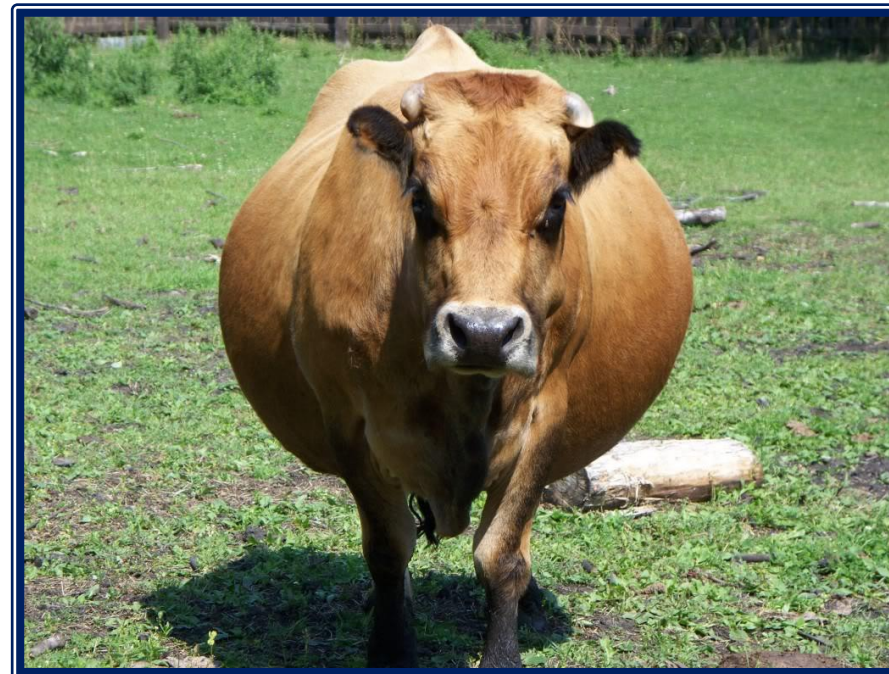
*Nimrud, Phoenician (900-700 BC)*
