

Jeroboam, King of Israel, Son of Jehoash (יָרָבְעָב), yarov'am)

Also known as Jeroboam II. Grandson of Jehu and son of Joash. The 14th king of the Northern Kingdom of Israel. Reigned 41 years, ca. 786–746 bc. **Successful politically and militarily**—he extended the boundaries of the northern kingdom (2 Kgs 14:25, 28) but "did evil in the sight of God" (2 Kgs 14:24). Jeroboam's reign is contained only in 2 Kgs 14:23–29.




Nimrud Ivory of a Lioness Killing a Nubian
