

- Through a Mediator Moses

WHY THE LAW?



Now I say that the heir, as long as he is a child, does not differ at all from a slave, though he is master of all,



Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!"

ABBA - Syriac

FATHER - Greek

But then, indeed, when you did not know God, you served those which by nature are not gods.



But now after you have known God, or rather are known by God, how is it that you turn again to **the weak** and **beggarly elements**, to which you desire again to be in bondage? WEAK = FEEBLE, SICK, WITHOUT STRENGTH

BEGGARLY = POOR, LACKING, DESTITUTE

You observe days and months and seasons and years. (4:10)

Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of a feast day or a new moon or a sabbath day: (Col. 2:16)

I am afraid for you, lest I have labored for you in vain. Brethren, I urge you to become like me, for I [became] like you. You have not injured me at all.

You know that because of physical infirmity I preached the gospel to you at the first. (probably referring to his thorn in the flesh – 2 Cor 12:7)

And my trial which was in my flesh you did not despise or reject, but you received me as an angel of God, [even] as Christ Jesus.

What then was the blessing you [enjoyed]? For I bear you witness that, if possible, you would have plucked out your own eyes and given them to me. Have I therefore become your enemy because I tell you the truth?

They zealously court you, [but] for no good; yes, <u>they want to exclude you, that you</u> <u>may be zealous for them.</u> But it is good to be **zealous in a good thing always**, and not only when I am present with you.

My little children, for whom I labor in birth again until Christ is formed in you, I would like to be present with you now and to change my tone; for I have doubts about you.

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
