and extravagant living

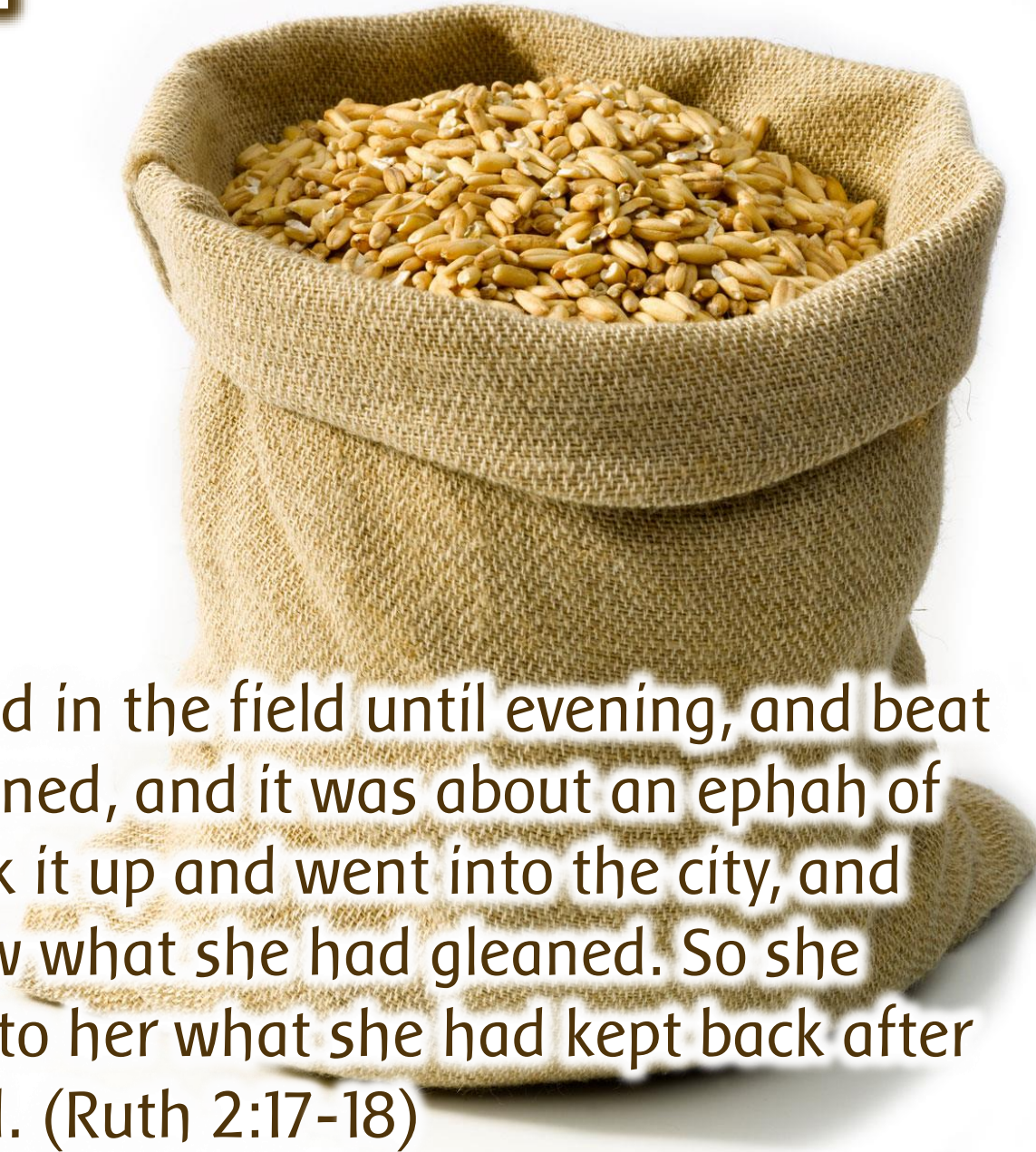
⁸ Remove falsehood and


