Anathema - a thing devoted to God by a vow or on account of being redeemed, and if an animal, to be slain; thus, a person devoted to destruction

- a) a curse
- b) a man accursed

Anathema - a thing devoted to God without hope of being redeemed, and if an animal, to be slain; therefore a person or thing doomed to destruction

a) a curse

b) a man accursed, devoted to the direst of woes

Now these things, brethren, I have in a figure transferred to myself and Apollos for your sakes; that in us ye might learn not to go beyond the things which are written; that no one of you be puffed up for the one against the other. (1 Cor 4:6)

I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, if any man shall add unto them, God shall add unto him the plagues which are written in this book: (Rev 22:18)

For I would have you know, brethren, that the gospel which was preached by me is not according to man. For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ.

WHAT WOULD BE THE CONSEQUENCES OF PAUL NOT HAVING APOSTOLIC AUTHORITY?

I used to persecute the church of God beyond measure and tried to destroy it.

And I was advancing in Judaism beyond many of my contemporaries among my countrymen, being more extremely zealous for my ancestral traditions.

- Holding the coats of those that stoned Stephen
- Casting his vote against Christians
- Chasing Christians all the way to Damascus
- circumcised the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; as touching the law, a Pharisee; (Php 3:5)
- I am a Jew, born in Tarsus of Cilicia, but brought up in this city, at the feet of Gamaliel, instructed according to the strict manner of the law of our fathers, being zealous for God, even as ye all are this day: (Acts 22:3)
