WHY THE LAW?

1. IT WAS ADDED BECAUSE OF TRANSGRESSIONS

- Through a Mediator Moses
- Until Jesus Should Come
- Incapable Of Saving, But Capable Of Restraining Sin

2. TO SHUT UP ALL UNDER SIN

• "But if you call yourself a Jew and rely on the law and boast in God...You who boast in the law dishonor God by breaking the law. (Rom 2:17-23)

3. IT WAS A TUTOR TO LEAD TO CHRIST

- Principles that lead toward Christ
- Examples that lead toward Christ
- Prophecies that lead toward Christ

This child happened by trying to force an heir and manipulate the situation, but it didn't work. This child happened through believing God and faithfully waiting for His promise.


SARAH
