Ephesians 1:3–14 (ESV)  
• But the **Helper, the Holy Spirit**, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things and **bring to your remembrance** all that I have said to you. (John 14:26)

• how the mystery was made known to me by revelation, as **I have written briefly. When you read this**, you can perceive my insight into the mystery of Christ, which was not made known to the sons of men in other generations as it has now been revealed to His holy apostles and prophets **by the Spirit**. (Eph 3:3-5)

• For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were **carried along by the Holy Spirit**. (2 Pet 1:21)  
**you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed **in Him**, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit,** <sup>14</sup> who is the guarantee of **our inheritance** until **we acquire** possession of it, to the praise of **His glory**.

## Ephesians 1:15–23 (ESV)

<sup>15</sup> For this reason, because I have heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love toward all the saints, <sup>16</sup> I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers, <sup>17</sup> that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him, <sup>18</sup> having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which He has called you, what are the riches of His glorious inheritance in the saints, <sup>19</sup> and what is the immeasurable greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His great might <sup>20</sup> that He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at his right hand in the heavenly places, <sup>21</sup> far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come. <sup>22</sup> And He put all things under His feet and gave Him as head over all things to the church, <sup>23</sup> which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.



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## Eph 2:1-3 (ESV)

<sup>1</sup> And you were **dead** in the **trespasses** and **sins** <sup>2</sup> in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience—  
<sup>3</sup> among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind.

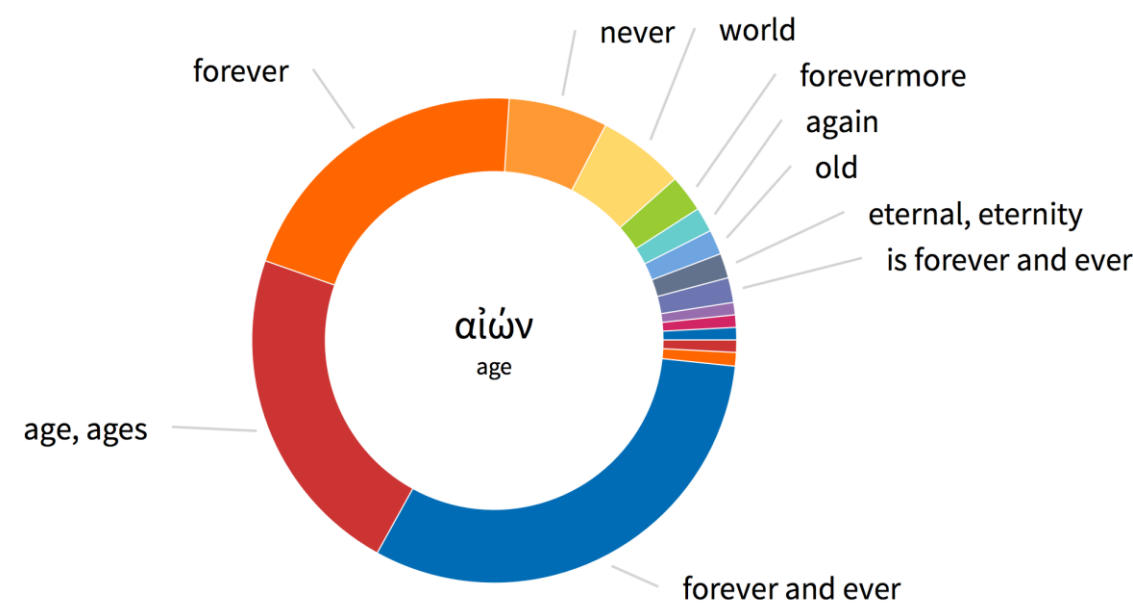

# Eph 2:1-3 (ESV)

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for Demas has forsaken me, having loved this **present world**, and has departed for Thessalonica—Crescens for Galatia, Titus for Dalmatia. (2 Tim 4:10)

who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from **this present evil age**, according to the will of our God and Father, (Gal 1:4)

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### Opposite prince

that He worked **in Christ** when He raised Him from the dead and **seated Him at His right hand** in the heavenly places, (Eph 1:20)

### Opposite spirit:

may give you the **Spirit of wisdom** and of revelation in the knowledge of Him, <sup>18</sup> having the eyes of your hearts enlightened (Eph 1:17-18)

### Opposite adoption:

for **adoption to Himself as sons** through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of His will (Eph 1:5)

### Opposite character:

that we should be **holy and blameless** before Him (Eph 1:4)
