The TRUTH about the day of our death:

Facts about **DEATH**:

- 1. Death is the cessation of the biological functions of the body, with a subsequent disintegration of the flesh back to the dust of the earth from whence it came and at the same time the spirit is released from the body.
- 2. Death is **inevitable** (Hebrews 8:28)
- 3. Death is merely a separation of the *spirit* from the physical *body* (James 2:26)
- 4. After death the spirit remains **conscious**.
- 5. Death is a temporary state.

Knowing that God cares gives us peace of mind.




Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of His godly ones

John 4:24 (Luke 24:35); 1 Corinthians 15:50


- No time

4) The Spiritual Blessings –

Revelation 2 & 3

- 2:7 the right to eat from the tree of life
- 2:11 will not be hurt by the second death
- 2:17 given some of the hidden manna
- 2:26 "TO HIM I WILL GIVE authority OVER THE NATIONS"
- 3:5 "I will not erase his name from the book of life, and I will confess his name before My Father"
- 3:12 "I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God"
- 3:21 "I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne"
