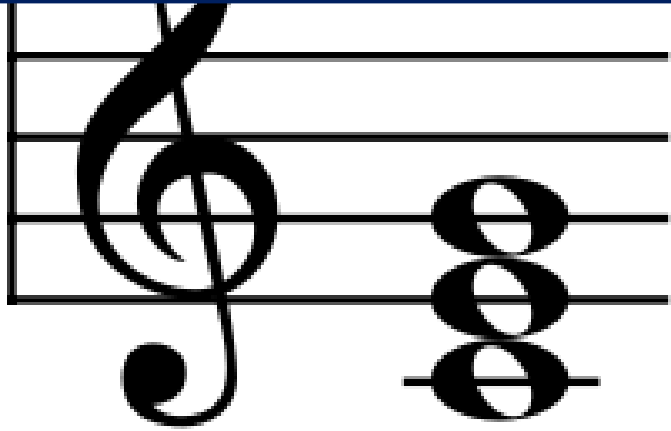


Brethren, join in following my example,
