A Reputation For Immorality, Lying, & Piracy

Somewhat ignored by Roman rule, so lawlessness abounded

The Character Of Titus

Most likely from Antioch – Acts 15:1-2 & Gal. 2:1

And when Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and questioning with them, *the brethren* appointed that Paul and Barnabas, **and certain other of them**, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question. (Acts 15:2)

Then after the space of fourteen years I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, **taking Titus also with me.** (Gal 2:1)

A Great Defender Of The Gentile Brethren – Gal. 2:3

But **not even Titus** who was with me, being a Greek, **was compelled to be circumcised:** (Gal 2:3)

But thanks be to God, who put **the same earnest care for you** into the heart of Titus. (2 Cor 8:16)

Paul's "Go To" Guy For Corinth – 2 Cor. 2:13, 7:6

Most Likely Converted By Paul – Tit. 1:4

to Titus, **my true child** after a common faith: Grace and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Saviour. (Titus 1:4)

When Paul needed someone to fix the disorder in Crete, Titus was an obvious pick
