A COMMON MYTH ON THIS SUBJECT

Some believe that the Nephilim were the byproducts of <u>angels</u> (sons of God) intermarrying with human women (daughters of men).

- The verse most commonly attached to this is "And angels that kept not their own principality, but left their proper habitation, he hath kept in everlasting bonds under darkness unto the judgment of the great day." (Jude 6)
- The theory is that rebellious angels fornicated with humans so that they could overthrow God and His plans.
- That is why the Nephilim were such big people and mighty.

IF THIS IS TRUE, WE SHOULD EXPECT TO SEE SEVERAL THINGS:

- 1. The Nephilim to be talked about as a "hybrid" not fully human.
- 2. The term 'sons of God' should be used to refer to angels in other parts of the Bible.
