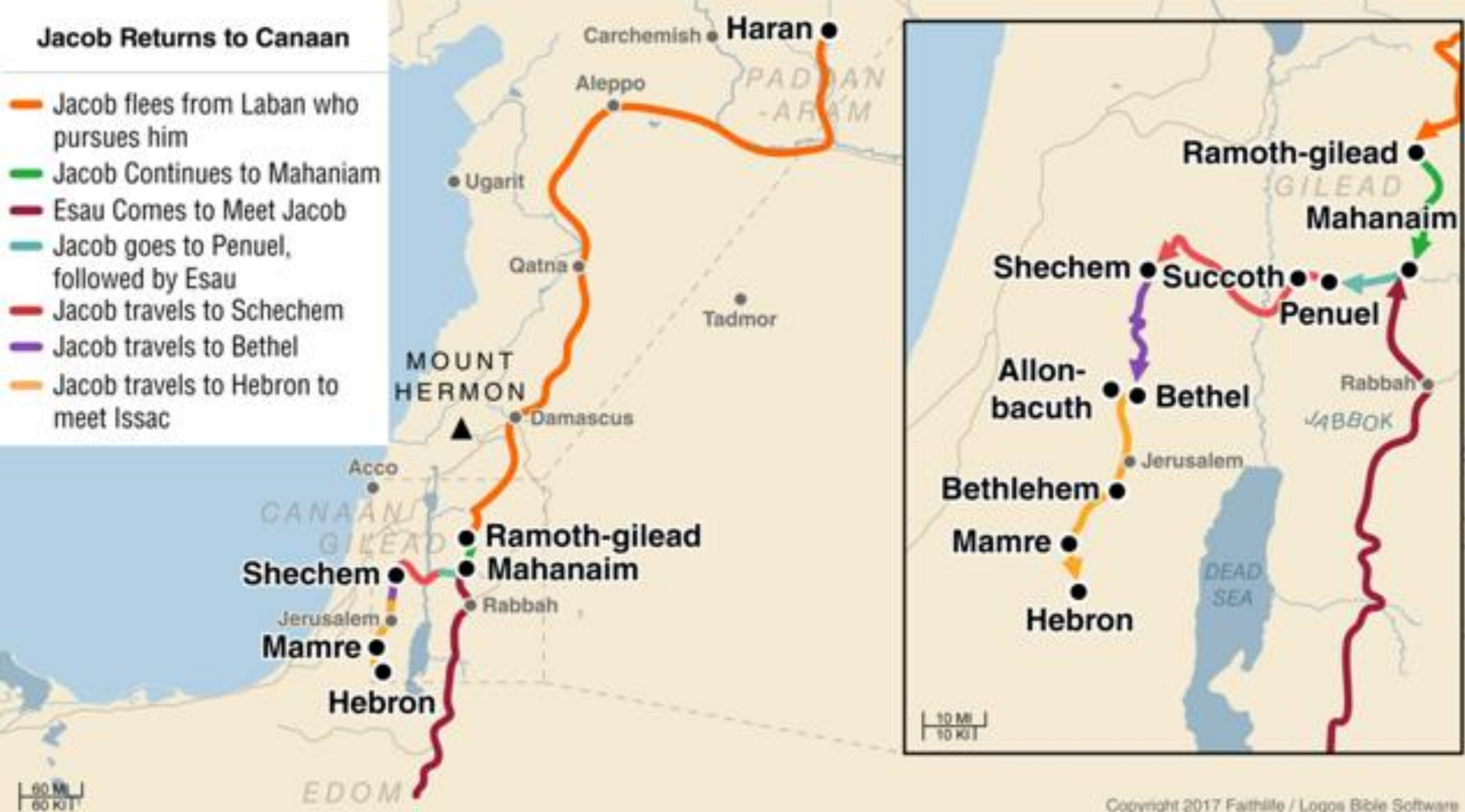

Jacob Returns to Canaan

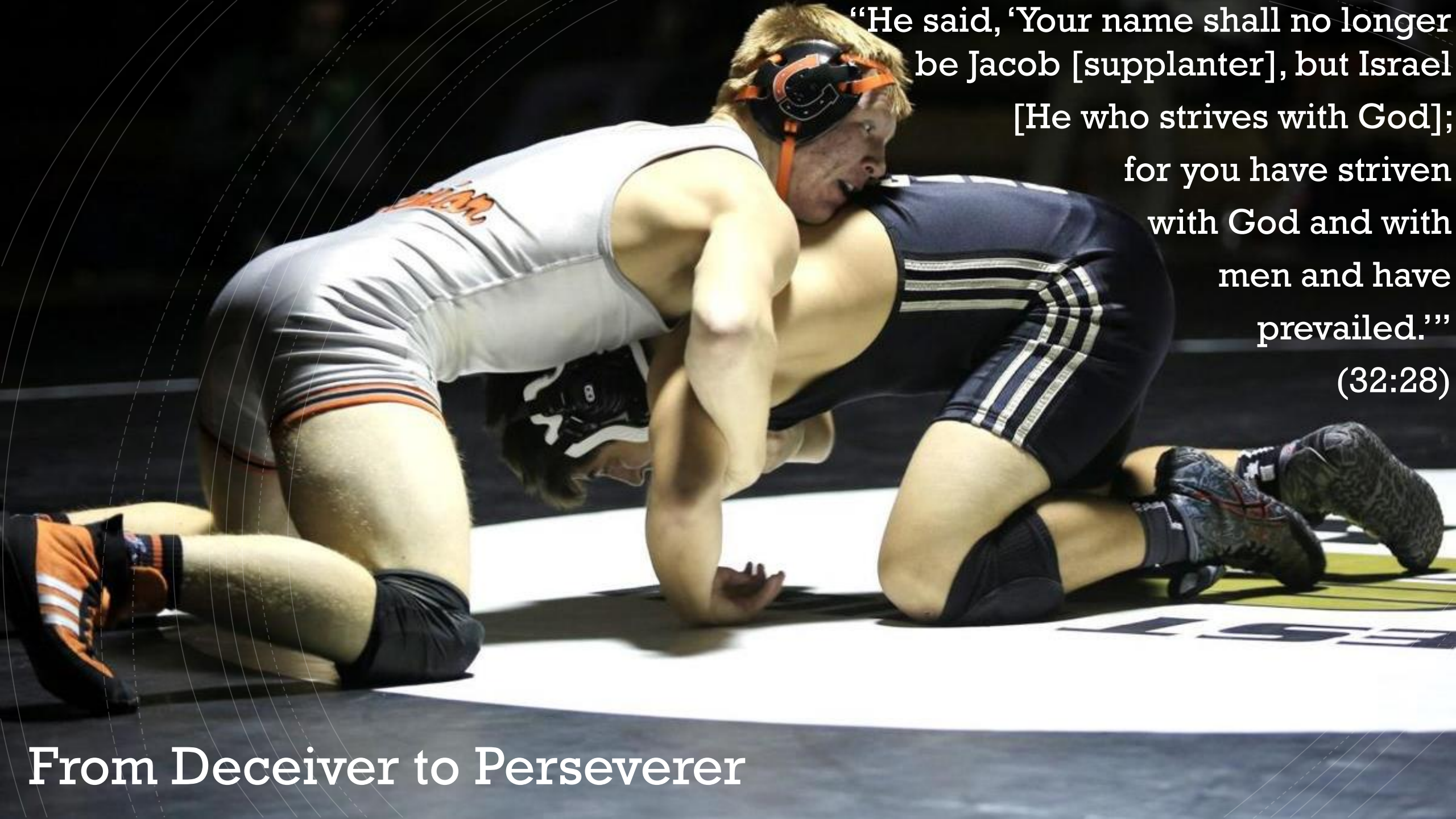
- Jacob flees from Laban who pursues him
